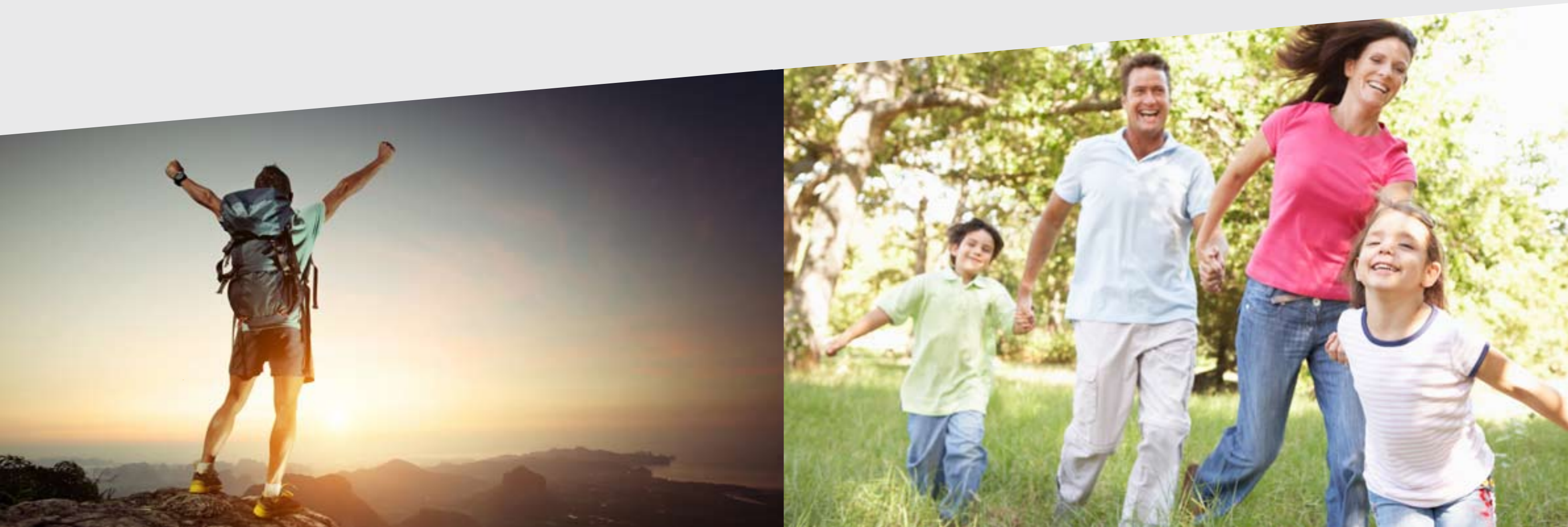

Munnar

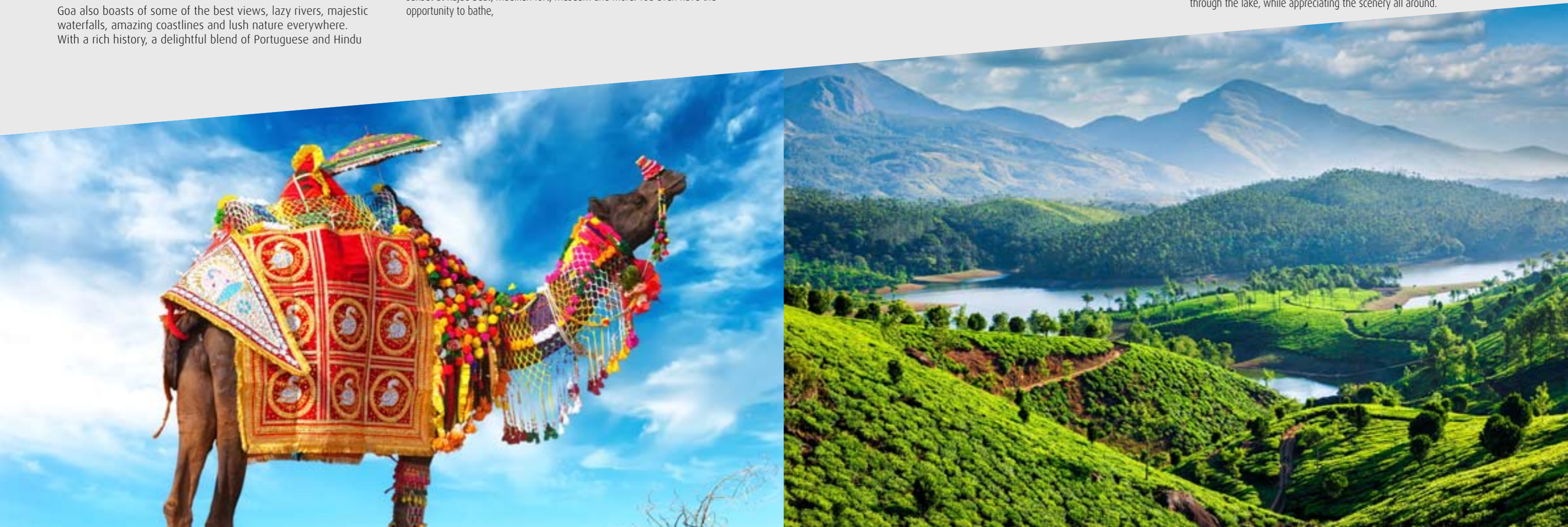

Corbett

One of the nine tiger reserves of Project Tiger, visitors throng to the national park to catch a glimpse of the famed gigantic, Bengal tigers. Additionally, Corbett National Park is also home to a large variety of flora and fauna. While at Corbett, you must go on tiger safaris, wildlife safaris and jeep safaris. Corbett National Park offers a range of other outdoor activities as well, including river crossing, rappelling, and angling.

Gangtok

Kodaikanal

Nestled amid the Palani hills, Kodaikanal is a magnificent hill station in Tamil Nadu - one of the most picturesque places in the state. The city is filled with slopes, bowers, creeks, enormous trees and lush green meadows. Coaker's Walk allows some of the best sights the hill station has to offer. Trekking and hiking in the hill station are activities that will make you fall in love with Kodaikanal. Plan an excursion (a day-long one) to Dindigul, Kukkal Caves, Thalaiyar Falls and Dolmen Circle to experience some thrilling sights in and around the hill station. Add to your itinerary a trip to Kodaikanal's churches, temples and museums as well.

Shimla

Once the summer capital during the British era, Shimla is now one of the top holiday destinations in India. Located close to the

Himalayas, the weather in Shimla is cool, regardless of the time of the year. The famous Mall Road never fails to attract visitors to the hill station.

The many temples and monasteries in Manali are well-worth a visit as well.



Nainital

One of Uttarakhand's most-visited hill stations, Nainital is a place of immense and awe-inspiring beauty. The spectacular landscapes and the cool climate makes Nainital a prime holiday destination. Places you should visit include the Aurobindo Ashram and St. John's Church. 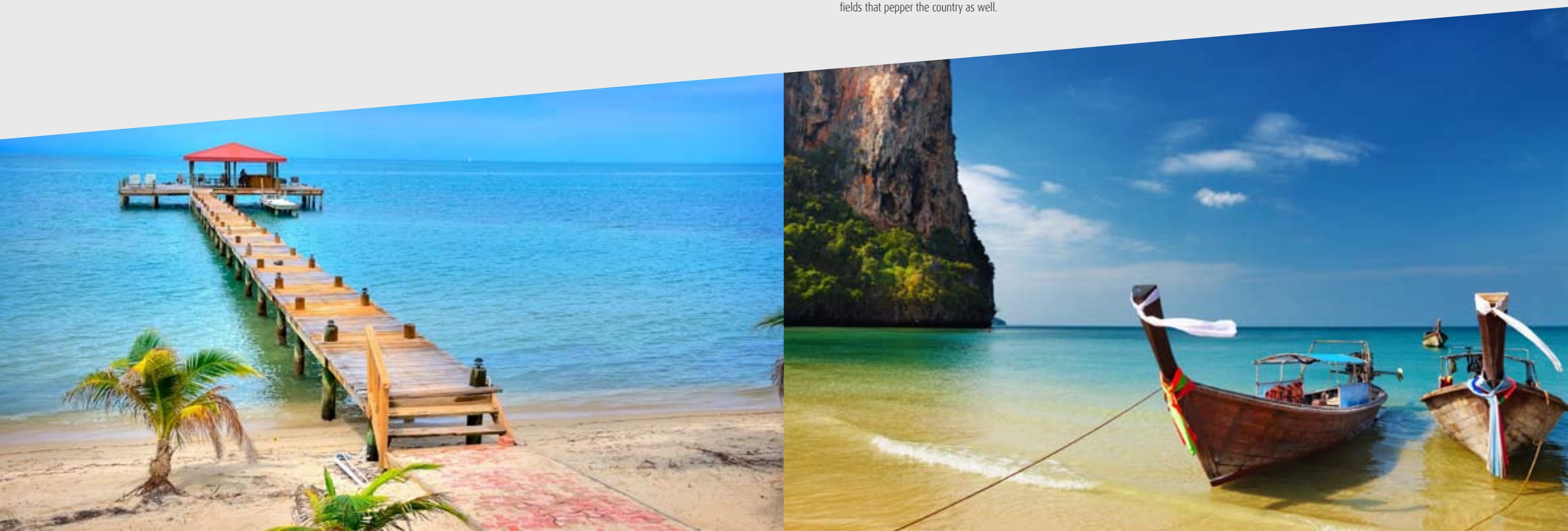
